**Apply now for a voluntary service with Schüler\*innen Helfen Leben (SHL) and Solidarity Action Day Movement Europe (SAME)!**

Become part of our international team and help organize the **Solidarity Action Day** alongside five other volunteers from Germany and Southeast Europe in our **Neumünster office**. Or work in an even more international setting at our **Lübeck office**. Get to know SHL as the largest youth-led organization in Germany and SAME as an international network of 12 organizations in 11 European countries.

## What to expect during your voluntary service in Germany:

- Be part of an **international team** of young people
- Live in a **shared apartment** with other volunteers
- Spend **13 months** in Germany, contributing to a meaningful cause
- Travel with your colleagues to **seminars** and a **10-day project trip** to Southeast Europe
- Receive **monthly pocket money**



## Additional Information for Volunteers:

- We cover the costs of **health insurance, visa, and other necessary expenses** related to the voluntary service
- One **round-trip journey** to your hometown is covered at a freely chosen time during your service
- Depending on the office location, a **good command of German and/or English (B1 level)** is required (no certificate needed). We support language learning before and during the voluntary service
- We assist with **visa applications** and **driver's license recognition**, covering all related expenses
- According to German regulations, volunteers must have their **permanent residence outside Germany**, and **German may not be their native language**

## Your Role in Lübeck:

In Lübeck, your work focuses on **youth involvement across Europe**. Together with two other volunteers, you will **promote** the Solidarity Action Day by organizing international youth activities.

## Your Role in Neumünster:

In addition to organizing the **Solidarity Action Day**, you will visit schools across Germany, conduct **workshops** on important social and political topics, and engage in youth involvement.
